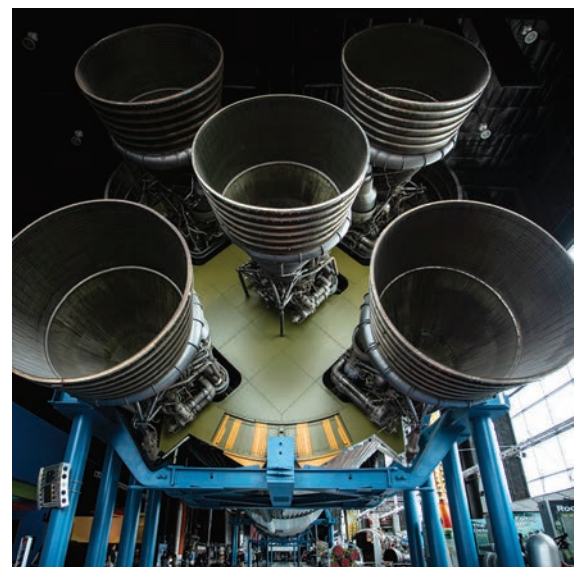

## Road Tripping in Alabama

With 81 carefully curated road trips to choose from, Alabama is the perfect destination—full of endless activities, fascinating history, delicious food, and unforgettable views. Check out these three itineraries.

### **ROAD TRIP #67: FLY INTO HISTORY**

Start your journey at USS Alabama Battleship Memorial Park, where you can explore an extensive aircraft collection including Marine One—the helicopter of four presidents. Next, head to Fort Rucker to visit the U.S. Army Aviation Museum, home to over 160 military aircraft. Drive on to Montgomery to view a full-scale model of the Wright Brothers' first flying machine, then head to the Tuskegee Airmen National Historic Site, a museum packed with exhibits about African-American pilots in WWII. Finally, end your trip in Huntsville at the renowned U.S. Space and Rocket Center.

### **ROAD TRIP #56: CRAVE THE COAST**

Indulge in a culinary tour of Alabama's Gulf Coast, starting with breakfast at Brick & Spoon in Orange Beach. From there, head north to sample your way through Baldwin County's locally made fare, from fluffy biscuits at Kitty's Café and homemade cheese at Sweet Home Farm to the impressive stalls at the Coastal Alabama Farmers & Fishermen's Market. End your tour back in Orange Beach with a sunset dinner at The Gulf, a seaside hideaway offering only the freshest local cuisine.

### **ROAD TRIP #22: ALABAMA'S RENAISSANCE CITY**

In the northwest corner of Alabama, the bustling river city of Florence warrants a road trip of its own. Start downtown and enjoy a stroll on Court Street, taking in the historic architecture and shopping at fashion icon Billy Reid's flagship store. Head to the University of North Alabama to explore its historic campus and visit mascots Leo III and Una at the George H. Carroll Lion Habitat. Then stop at the birthplace of Blues legend W.C. Handy before returning to Court Street for a bite to eat at Trowbridge's Ice Cream & Sandwich Bar, a favorite since 1918.
